School-Specific Factors & Recommendations

[Edward J. Bloustein School of Planning and Public Policy](#)

The Bloustein School offers five majors: city and regional planning (170), health administration (501), public health (832), public policy (833), and urban planning and design (971). Currently matriculated students at Rutgers (New Brunswick, Camden or Newark) may submit an online school-to-school transfer application through [RU Admissions' School-to-School Transfer site](#) upon reviewing the [criteria for admissions](#). School of Arts and Sciences - NB students can pursue these majors without transferring. Bloustein School requirements include:

- **Prior Credits Earned:** Minimum of 30 RU credits
- **GPA:** Rutgers cumulative GPA of 2.50 or better by end of semester in which applying.

[Rutgers Business School–New Brunswick](#)

The Rutgers Business School: Undergraduate-New Brunswick offers six majors leading to the Bachelor of Science degree: accounting (010), business analytics and information technology (136), finance (390), leadership and management (605), marketing (630), and supply chain management (799). RBS requirements include:

- **Prior Credits Earned:** Minimum of 24 credits at Rutgers University prior to transfer.
- **GPA:** A Rutgers cumulative GPA of 3.000 or better by end of semester in which applying.
 - Equivalent of College Writing 355:101 with "C" or better

- Newark: 21:350:101 and 102
- Camden: 50:989:101 and 102
 - Pre-calculus with "C" or better (see RBS links for campus-specific courses)

School of Arts and Sciences

SAS considers applications from students in all the undergraduate colleges at RU–Camden and RU–Newark, except for University College satellite programs. School-to-school transfer is NOT available to second-degree students in any RU–Camden or RU–Newark undergraduate colleges. SAS requirements include:

- **Prior Credits Earned:** Must have completed at least two Fall/Spring semesters, including the current semester, with a minimum of 12 graded degree credits.
- **GPA:** A cumulative GPA of 3.000 according to SAS-NB policies by end of semester in which applying.
 - Equivalent of College Writing 355:101 with "C" or better
 - Newark: 21:355:101 and 102
 - Camden: 50:989:101 and 102

School of Engineering

Currently matriculated students at RU (New Brunswick, Camden, or Newark) may submit an online application at [RU Admissions' School-to-School Transfer site](#). SOE requirements include:

- **Prior Credits Earned:** Must complete a minimum of 12 credits at RU prior to transfer.
- **GPA:** Students must complete and obtain a 2.75 or better for Camden/Newark) AND complete Calculus I and II (01:640:151 & 152), Analytical Physics I (01:750:123 & 124), and Chemistry I (01:160:159) before the transfer.
 - No D's or F's in STEM courses when application is submitted.
 - *While Chemistry I Lab - Introduction to Experimentation 01:160:171 (1 credit) is not required to transfer to SoE it is a graduation requirement and HIGHLY RECOMMENDED to complete this course while enrolling in Chemistry 159 or Chem 161 before transfer.
- For transfer evaluation, School of Engineering (SoE) recognizes the following course equivalencies:
 - 01:640:151 = 01:640:135 (Please note that for Calculus II, 01:640:136 CANNOT be used to replace 01:640:152)
 - 01:160:159* = 01:160:161 = 01:160:163

- 01:750:123/124 = 01:750:203/205 = 01:750:115/116 = 01:750:271/275 = 01:750:201 = 01:750:193

School of Environmental and Biological Sciences

The School of Environmental and Biological Sciences (SEBS) welcomes applications for admission from students enrolled at other RU schools. SEBS requirements include:

- **Prior Credits Earned:** A minimum of 12 credits at RU by the end of the current semester. Students must pursue [a major offered by the School of Environmental and Biological Sciences](#) and have progress in course work related to intended SEBS major.
- **GPA:** Rutgers cumulative GPA of 2.75 or better by end of semester in which applying.
 - Equivalent of College Writing 355:101 with "C" or better
 - Newark: 21:350:101 and 102
 - Camden: 50:350:100 and 102, or 50:350:101 and 102
 - Pre-calculus with "C" or better
 - Newark: 21:640:114
 - Camden: 50:640:115

School of Management and Labor Relations

Currently matriculated students at Rutgers (New Brunswick, Camden or Newark) may submit an online school-to-school transfer application through [RU Admissions' School-to-School Transfer site](#) upon reviewing the [criteria for admissions](#). SMLR requirements include:

- **Prior Credits Earned:** Minimum of 24 RU credits by end of Spring.
- **GPA:** Rutgers cumulative GPA of 2.00 or better by end of semester in which applying.
 - Equivalent of College Writing 355:101 with "C" or better
 - Newark: 21:350:101 and 102
 - Camden: 50:350:100 and 102, or 50:350:101 and 102
 - The school-to-school transfer application is **NOT** permitted for non-matriculated (non-degree) students.
