

## **Rutgers School of Nursing-Camden**

**Rutgers School of Nursing-Camden accepts school-to-school transfer applications for the spring and fall semesters. Students interested in applying for admission for spring may submit a school-to-school transfer application for the Accelerated BS (ABS) program between October 1, 2015 and December 15, 2015. For fall 2016, students may submit a school-to-school transfer application online at this site for the traditional program or the ABS program between February 1, 2016 and March 1, 2016. Please review the following information to become familiar with admission requirements for the Rutgers School of Nursing-Camden.**

(Please note that summer 2016 courses may be required for progression in the traditional undergraduate curriculum but not the ABS curriculum.)

### **1. Criteria for Admission**

#### **Credits**

- Traditional students should follow the curricular plan for students in the School of Nursing-Camden. Students must be full time (12 or more credits) during the fall semester prior to applying as a school-to-school transfer, and must complete the following courses or their equivalents with a minimum grade of C (2.0) by the end of the spring 2016 semester to be admitted as a sophomore:
  - 50:120:127 Principles of Biology OR 50:120:101 General Biology I
  - 50:160:103 General Organic and Biochemistry or General Chemistry I and II with labs (transfer) or two higher level chemistry courses with labs
  - 50:350:101 English Composition I
  - 50:350:102 English Composition II
  - 50:120:231 Clinical Aspects of Human Genetics
  - 50:830:250 Statistics for Social Sciences or 50:960:183 Elementary applied statistics
  - 50:830:101 Introduction to Psychology
  - 50:920:207 Introduction to Sociology

To be admitted as a junior in the traditional program, students must have also completed the following courses by the end of the spring semester

- Anatomy and Physiology I and II with labs (50:120:253; 50:120:255; 50:120:254; 50:120:256)
- Microbiology (50:120:211 and 50:120:212)
- Human Development (50:830:222)
- Biomedical ethics (50:730:249)
- Nutrition (57:705:255)

#### **Grade-Point Average**

- Students must have earned a minimum cumulative grade-point average of 2.5 at Rutgers on a full-time credit load. While this is the minimum, students with higher GPAs are admitted before students with lower GPAs. Students should not have failed and repeated any more than one required course.

## **Other**

- Students must indicate on their application if they are currently under review for disciplinary action.
- Students applying to the ABS program should see the list of prerequisites on the ABS curriculum sheet.
- Students desiring the ABS program who are currently in a degree-granting program and who will finish degree requirements in December should use the re-enrollment application.

## **2. Conditions**

- Students must remain in good academic standing at their current school and satisfactorily complete the fall and spring semester courses. Students with final grades that are not consistent with the academic record upon which the initial offer of admission was made may be rescinded.
- If admitted to the sophomore class, students must complete the course, “Seminar on Professional Nursing” (57:705:101), with a minimum grade of C+ (2.5) during the spring or summer session 2016. Registration to the nursing seminar course in the spring semester will be granted via special permission numbers to students in other schools who have or intend to fill out a school-to-school transfer application. If students take this course in the spring, they will not have to take summer courses if they are admitted as a sophomore.
- If admitted to the junior class, students must complete the following courses with a minimum grade of C+ (2.5) during summer session 2016:
  - 57:705:101 (2 credits) Seminar on Professional Nursing
  - 57:705:210/211 (4 credits) Basic Clinical Competencies
  - 57:705:202 (3 credits) Wellness and Health Assessment
- Additional conditions (e.g., background checks, drug screening, fingerprinting, health requirements, and CPR) will be specified in the notification message to admitted students.

## **3. Required Documents**

- Additional conditions will be specified in the notification message to admitted students. Upon admission to the School of Nursing, students must provide an official transcript from any college(s) they have attended in addition to Rutgers.
- Any attempt to hide prior unfavorable transcripts or failure to submit transcripts from other nursing schools will result in rescission of admission.
- Any failure of courses in progress will result in rescission of admission.
- Any failure of courses taken during the summer sessions will result in rescission of admission.

## **4. Graduation Requirements**

Students must successfully complete a minimum of 123 credits for the 4-year pre-licensure BSN program, and a minimum of 89 credits for the RN to BSN program.

- Students must earn a minimum of 30 of their final 42 credits at Rutgers.
- Students are responsible for notifying the registrar concerning their expected date of graduation.

## **6. Application Deadline/Procedure and Notification Schedule**

- Students interested in applying for admission to the spring ABS program may submit a school-to-school transfer application between October 1, 2015 and December 15, 2015 with a notification date of January 13 or sooner.
- For fall 2016, students may submit a school-to-school transfer application online at this site for the traditional program or the ABS program between February 1, 2016 and March 5, 2016 with notification by April 30 or sooner.

## **7. Orientation/Advising/Registration Information**

- Students are required to attend orientation prior to the start of summer session I at which time they will register for summer and fall courses.

## **8. College Enrollment**

- By submitting an application, an admitted student declares his/her intention to enroll at Rutgers School of Nursing – Camden for the summer 2016 term. The dean's office will notify the University Registrar to change the student's school registration to Rutgers School of Nursing – Camden (school code # 57).

## **9. Withdrawal of Application**

- Prior to a decision, an applicant may withdraw his/her application by visiting the status screen and inserting the letter "W" in the decision field.

## **10. Withdrawal After Admission**

- If an admitted student is unable to enroll in Rutgers School of Nursing – Camden, he/she must select the "Decline Transfer" button displayed in their admission email within the timeframe indicated so that his/her college of registration may be modified accordingly. Without this notice, the college of registration will remain as Rutgers School of Nursing – Camden (school code # 57).

## **11. University Housing**

housing application. Housing accommodations are assigned to school-to-school transfer students on a space-available basis.

**12. Accommodation Under ADA/Section 504**

- Students currently receiving accommodation should inform their current campus coordinator of their intention to transfer to facilitate uninterrupted accommodations.

**13. Financial Aid**

- A transfer may affect financial aid and/or scholarships. Students should contact financial aid if they have any questions.
